Arrival Time: Contestants and families can arrive on Friday after 10 p.m. If you arrive prior to 10 pm you may enter but will have to purchase tickets to enter.

- 1:00 PM JH and HS Performance (1st go)

Sunday:

- 7:30 AM Sunday School
- 8:00 AM Church Service
- 9:00 AM Maverick and Peewee Performance (2nd go) - Maverick and Peewee Awards immediately following Performance
- 1:00 PM JH and HS Performance (2nd go) - HS and JH awards immediately following performance

Admission: Each contestant will receive one ticket for themselves plus one additional ticket for both Saturday and Sunday. If you arrive prior to 10 pm Friday tickets will be required for everyone including the contestant. Children 12 and under are free. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$12.50 per day through VHSRA. You must specify the number of tickets you need for each day during call-in. Tickets will be \$20/day if bought at the gate

Parking: Each family will receive one parking pass for the weekend

Stalls: No stalls are available. You may set up portable pens.

Trailer/Camper Hook-ups: There are no hookups available. Generators are allowed.

Mandatory Contestant Meeting: There will be no formal contestant meeting. Any pertinent information will be emailed out prior to the rodeo and posted at the arena.

Call in will be on Monday, August 22, 2022, from 8am to 8pm using the online link that will be shared with your State Secretary and also posted on our website. Once you have called in you are responsible for your fees unless you present written Med out or Vet out documentation.

Awards: We will be awarding All Around Buckles for Peewee, Maverick Girl, Maverick Boy, JH Girl, JH Boy, HS Girl, HS Boy. We will also give out average awards for each event for all divisions.

Additional Information: Our arena will be very close to the truck and tractor pull track and it could be quite noisy Friday and Saturday nights. Be prepared if your horse is easily excitable.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are listed below and are charged for each go of the rodeo. **EXAMPLE** if the entry for an event is \$30 and you are entering that event both days (goes) of the rodeo you will pay \$60 for that event. Each contestant will also owe a \$10.00 administrative fee for the weekend. Entry fees will be paid to your home state.
